Appellation:	Paso Robles(Westside)
Vineyard:	Curtis Lockshaw
Clone(s):	California clone 6
Harvest:	By hand on September 6, 2007
Yields:	3 ½ tons per acre
Crush:	Whole berry destemmed and lightly crushed
Innoculum:	Rhone D-80 after 4 day cold maceration
Fermentation:	7 days, without punchdowns 2 times daily
Barrel regime:	20% new American/ 80% used French for 14 months in barrel
Racking:	Once April 2008, then prior to bottling March 2009
Bottling:	March 13, 2009 without fining or filtration
TA:	0.524 g/100ml
PH:	3.95
Production:	175 cases

Winemaker's Notes:

This wine is a literal yule log of aromas-incense cedar, pomegranate, dried cranberry, clove and bay leaf. In the mouth, flavors of wild berry and meaty Santa Rosa plum dominate, and the wine finishes smooth, silky and very cinnamony. The texture has a little fat to it, but not too heavy.-*Bill Wathen*
